What can the money be spent on?

The funding is to help you meet with other interested people who have ideas and/or expertise, including lived experience, about making a difference to the experience of later life.

The sorts of things you might use the money for include:

- Venue hire for a meeting or small conference/ event
- Travel expenses
- Expenses to enable you or a small group to go and visit another group or project who are doing something similar and of interest to you in helping you develop your ideas.
- Fees to attend a conference or training event to increase your ability to put your ideas into practice
- To pay for an expert practitioner or speaker's time where necessary

*The only thing that funds cannot be spent on is the salary or a contribution towards paying for your time to co-ordinate or be involved in this activity; i.e. no session fees, wages etc.

What do I have to do to get the money?

You need to apply; there is a short application form, (which could also be completed over the phone by talking to your local delivery organisation – Community Council for Somerset) or by meeting up with them to discuss your application.

You need to describe what you want to do and how this will help to make a contribution to improving the experience of later life.

You will be asked to record your expenditure and provide receipts for anything over £100.
