Admiral Nurses

The Royal British Legion Admiral Nursing Service is a Community Dementia Nurse Service which offers specialist support, information and advice to the carers of people with Dementia.

Admiral Nurses are mental health nurses specialising in dementia care.

Am I Eligible?

To qualify for this service the carer or person with dementia would need to be a beneficiary of the Royal British Legion. The service is only available to those meeting the legion's Eligibility criteria; this includes anyone who has worked for the armed forces for at least seven days as a regular or reservist, their families and carers. This also includes Widows, Widowers, cohabiting partner or civil partners.

How can the Admiral Nurses help me?

The Royal British Legion Admiral Nurses will work with carers, families and people with Dementia. The services they offer can include:

- Practical Advice
- Helping carers to develop and improve skills in care giving
- Relevant information that can easily be understood
- Liaise with other professionals and organisation's to ensure that families obtain co-ordinated support
- Psychological support to help understand and deal with feelings and emotions
- Therapeutic, educational and social support carer groups
